The April 6th meeting was called to order, roll call taken, and March minutes read. Doug Manson made a motion to accept the minutes; seconded by Tony White. Motion passed. We had 14 members in attendance.

The Treasurer reported the cost of the new flight line fence. The field rent was paid.

Under old business the new flight line fence was discussed.

New Business: Joe Hahn contacted Bowman concessions about working our Fun Fly. They offer many types of sandwiches and drinks. It wouldn't cost the club anything and if they sold enough food the club could make a little money. Daryl Grossnickle made a motion that we have Bowman supply the food for the Fun Fly; seconded by Gary Watt. Motion passed.

Gary Watt and Don Smith serviced the mowers. Lee Vestal will make up a mowing list and e-mail it out and post it at the field.

Doug Manson made a motion that Lee Vestal becomes the clubs Vice President and Daryl Grossnickle the Safety Officer; seconded by Gary Watt. Motion passed.

Earl Scherzinger suggested we have a sign posted prohibiting any alcohol at the field. Doug Manson made a motion we change the by-laws to state "Zero Tolerance of Alcohol"; seconded by Tony White. Motion passed. It can be made official after 30 days. Also an addition to the by-laws stating "Fireworks prohibited except by special consent of the Safety Officer" and also posted on a sign.

We were reminded to pick up after ourselves while at the field. Todd Walker asks us to welcome visitors that stop by the field.

Mike Calvert reported it costs \$216 for crabgrass control for the field. Gary Webb made a motion for the club to buy it; seconded by Joe Hahn. Motion passed.

Daryl Grossnickle reported it cost \$190 a day to rent a 3 ton roller. Joe Hahn and Daryl Grossnickle volunteered to take care of getting it.

We were reminded to fly within the field's boundaries and not over the road.

Lee Vestal made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Gary Watt. Meeting was adjourned
